Traveling I - 91 North – Take Exit 15. At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Route 68 West. Proceed to 7th traffic light (intersection of Route 68 and North Main Street Extension). Take a left turn onto North Main Street Extension. At the first traffic light, take a left into driveway of 860/866. At the top of the hill proceed to the building straight ahead.

Traveling I - 91 South – Take Exit 15. At the end of the exit ramp, turn right onto Route 68 West. Proceed to 6th traffic light (intersection of Route 68 and North Main Street Extension). Take a left turn onto North Main Street Extension. At the first traffic light, take a left into driveway of 860/866. At the top of the hill proceed to the building straight ahead.

Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15 Going North) Exit 66

At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Route 5 South. Proceed approximately ¼ mile to the 3rd traffic light, following signs to Route 68. At top of hill, turn left on Route 68 East. At first traffic light, turn right onto North Main Street Extension. At the first traffic light, take a left at the driveway of 860/866. At the top of the hill proceed to the building straight ahead.

Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15 Going South) Exit 66

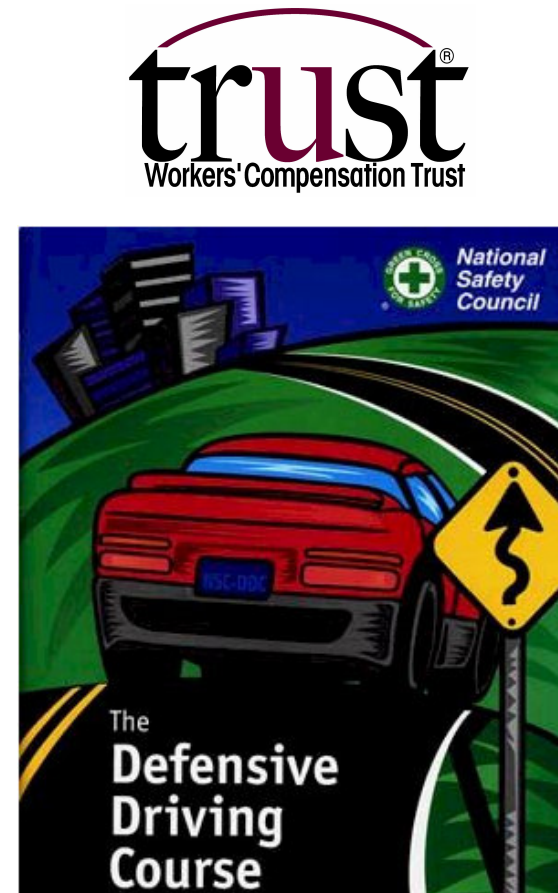
At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Route 5 South. Proceed approximately ¼ mile to the 5th traffic light, following sign to Route 68. At top of hill turn left on Route 68 East. At first traffic light, turn right onto North Main Street Extension. At the traffic light, take a left at the driveway of 860/866. At the top of the hill proceed to the building straight ahead.

From Interstate 84: Exit 27

Proceed on Route 691 East to the Wilbur Cross Parkway Southbound and follow directions above.

Employees who drive frequently or who transport others are most at risk of injury due to a collision.

The Trust recognizes the need for advanced driving skills training and is offering a *specialized 4-hour concentrated driver improvement program*, developed by the National Safety Council, which sets the standard for driver improvement education. The Trust has been approved as a Public Defensive Driving Training Center by the National Safety Council and has 4 trainers who are approved to present the program. The course is taught using a national standardized format. It is based on real life experiences of instructors, fleet safety managers and insurance providers and teaches practical knowledge and techniques to avoid accidents and choose safe, responsible driving behaviors.

A Certificate of Completion is provided to each participant who attends the full program. Additionally, most insurance companies recognize the National Safety Council Defensive Driver Program and may offer *discounts to drivers* who complete the program. This program is ideal for employees of VNA/Nursing/Home Health, Community Organizations and Group Homes, Schools, Ambulance Services and other public or private service providers who face the challenge of collision free driving.

The program focuses on:

- Adverse conditions and defenses for road, traffic, vehicle, and driver
- Collision prevention formula
- 6 unsafe driving behaviors which contribute to crashes and collisions
- Ways to reduce stress and aggression behind the wheel
- Weather: hazards and defenses
- Rules, regulations and responsible driving
- Common driver errors
- Intersection safety
- Ways to avoid confrontations with aggressive drivers
