Traveling I - 91 North – Take Exit 15. At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Route 68 West. Proceed to 7th traffic light (intersection of Route 68 and North Main Street Extension). Take a left turn onto North Main Street Extension. At the first traffic light, take a left into driveway of 860/866. At the top of the hill proceed to the building straight ahead.

Traveling I - 91 South – Take Exit 15. At the end of the exit ramp, turn right onto Route 68 West. Proceed to 6th traffic light (intersection of Route 68 and North Main Street Extension). Take a left turn onto North Main Street Extension. At the first traffic light, take a left into driveway of 860/866. At the top of the hill proceed to the building straight ahead.

Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15 Going North) Exit 66
At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Route 5 South. Proceed approximately ¼ mile to the 3rd traffic light, following signs to Route 68. At top of hill, turn left on Route 68 East. At first traffic light, turn right onto North Main Street Extension. At the first traffic light, take a left at the driveway of 860/866. At the top of the hill proceed to the building straight ahead.

Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15 Going South) Exit 66
At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Route 5 South. Proceed approximately ¼ mile to the 5th traffic light, following sign to Route 68. At top of hill turn left on Route 68 East. At first traffic light, turn right onto North Main Street Extension. At the traffic light, take a left at the driveway of 860/866. At the top of the hill proceed to the building straight ahead.

From Interstate 84: Exit 27

Proceed on Route 691 East to the Wilbur Cross Parkway Southbound and follow directions above.

Offered for the first time at the Trust, this seminar qualifies under the Connecticut Public Health Code which requires each food service establishment to employ one “Qualified Food Operator” who is in a supervisory position. In compliance with Section 19-13-B42, the “Qualified Food Operator” must be able to demonstrate knowledge of safe food handling techniques. Completing the offered course and passing the post course CFP/ANSI Accredited Certification Examination from the National Registry of Food Safety Professionals, attests to the manager’s knowledge of the principles within a food service operation.

Topics Covered

- ✓ Understand the dangers associated with foodborne illness
- ✓ Identify the five major risk factors that contribute to foodborne disease outbreaks
- ✓ Identify which people are at greatest risk for getting a foodborne illness
- ✓ Describe the characteristics of potentially hazardous foods
- ✓ Understand the legal rights of a customer and the responsibility of the food service manager
- ✓ Understand 17 key elements that the U.S. Food and Drug Administration says the food service manager or person in charge must know

The training manual is the newly revised NSF HealthGuard™ Professional Food Manager Certification course book, Version 5.0. *A copy of the manual is given as part of the course to each student one week prior to the actual training and certification examination.* The manuals are available in both English and Spanish. New information on the 2009 Food Code including, ethnic foods, foodborne viruses, handwashing and gloves, thermometer calibration, sous-vide and reduced-oxygen packaging of foods, and oxygen-bleach products; among other new topics will be included.
