DIRECTIONS TO THE TRUST

Traveling I - 91 North – Take Exit 15. At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Route 68 West. Proceed to 6th traffic light. Take a left turn onto Barnes Industrial Road South. We are at #47 (the first building on the right).

Traveling I - 91 South – Take Exit 15. At the end of the exit ramp, turn right onto Route 68 West. Proceed to 5th traffic light. Take a left turn onto Barnes Industrial Road South. We are at #47 (the first building on the right).

Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15 Going North) Exit 66

At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Route 5 South. Proceed approximately ¼ mile to the 3rd traffic light, following signs to Route 68. At top of hill, turn left on Route 68 East. At the second traffic light, turn right onto Barnes Industrial Road South. We are at #47 (the first building on the right).

Wilbur Cross Parkway (Route 15 Going South) Exit 66

At the end of the exit ramp, turn left onto Route 5 South. Proceed approximately ¼ mile to the 5th traffic light, following sign to Route 68. At top of hill, turn left on Route 68 East. At the second traffic light, turn right onto Barnes Industrial Road South. We are at #47 (the first building on the right).

From Interstate 84: Exit 27

Proceed on Route 691 East to the Wilbur Cross Parkway Southbound and follow directions above.

Anyone who works in dementia care settings or with individuals with Alzheimer's Disease requires a baseline knowledge about the disease, its effects on families, and proven strategies for creating optimal care. The Dementia Care Specialist Training™ program is an eight-hour course designed to meet this need. It's for health care professionals who want to understand more about the illness; those who want to learn new proven techniques. Appropriate attendees include nurses, certified nursing assistants, home health aides, recreation therapists, occupational and physical therapists, housekeepers, dietary staff and administrative staff.
